### WH – QUESTIONS?

WH	Helping verb-to be	Subject	VERB	Object	?
WHAT	DO	you	eat	for dinner usually	?
WHERE	DOES	your sister	buy	buy her groceries	?
WHEN	IS	the plane	landing	at JFK airport	?
WHO	ARE	your parents	inviting	for dinner	?
WHOM	DID	Johnny	buy	his bike from	?
WHY	WAS	the train	late	last night	?
HOW	AM	I	sending	a mail without Internet	?

#### Wh – Questions:

Wh- questions begin with a question word such as what, where, when, why, who, whom, how

We put the helping verb or to be before the subject. The subject and the helping verb change place:

In positive: You are talking to your friend on the phone.

In question: Who are you talking to on the phone?

Question word + helping verb + subject + verb + object?

#### Yes/No questions:

Yes/No questions begin with the helping verb (am/is/are/do/does/was/were/will) which is followed by a subject. We usually answer these questions with Yes or No.

They are very easy to make!

Just switch the place of the subject and the helping verb. For example:

In positive: She is happy.

In question: Is she happy?

When the main verb is in the **Present Simple**, we form the question with adding the helping verb **Do/Does**. (See also Lesson 2.)

- Does Johnny live in Tel Aviv? - Yes, he does.

When the main verb is in the **Past Simple**, we form the question with adding the helping verb **Did**. (See also Lesson 6.)

- Did you enjoy the movie last night? - Yes, I did.
